SESSION LAW 2006-22 HOUSE BILL 1852

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT NO GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY OUTSIDE OF LINCOLN COUNTY MAY ANNEX ANY PORTION OF THAT COUNTY, OR EXTEND ITS EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION INTO LINCOLN COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no incorporated city, town, or village outside of Lincoln County may annex any territory within Lincoln County or extend its extraterritorial planning jurisdiction into Lincoln County.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
