A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REGULATE HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN GREENE
2 COUNTY AND TO REQUIRE WRITTEN PERMISSION BEFORE HUNTING
3 ON THE POSTED LANDS OF ANOTHER IN GREENE COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful for a person to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal
7 or game bird with a firearm or bow and arrow, in the person's possession, from, on, or
8 across the right-of-way of a public road in Greene County.

9 **SECTION 2.** It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or game
10 bird on the posted lands of another in Greene County without having on one's person the
11 written permission of the owner or lessee dated within the current hunting season.

12 **SECTION 3.** As used in this act, the terms "to hunt" and "to take" are
13 defined as provided in G.S. 113-130.

14 **SECTION 4.** Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor, punishable for
15 a first offense by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and punishable
16 for a second or subsequent offense by a fine of not less than two hundred dollars
17 (\$200.00).

18 **SECTION 5.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the
19 Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers
20 with general subject matter jurisdiction.

21 **SECTION 6.** This act applies only to Greene County.

22 **SECTION 7.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2006, and applies to
23 offenses committed on or after that date.
