1 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 126-5 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 2 "(c9) Article 16 of this Chapter shall apply to all State employees, including all 3 employees of The University of North Carolina, public school employees, and 4 community college employees." 5 SECTION 3. By November 1, 2006, the State Personnel Commission, The 6 University of North Carolina, the State Board of Education, and the Community 7 Colleges System Office shall take all steps necessary to participate in the Basic Pilot 8 Program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security for the 9 verification of the legal status of newly hired employees. 10 **SECTION 4.** From funds appropriated to the Department of Administration, 11 the Office of State Personnel shall provide technical assistance and training to State 12 agencies, departments, institutions, universities, and local subdivisions under 13 14 of this act. Local education agencies, the State Board of Education and community 15 colleges may consult with the Office of State Personnel in carrying out and monitoring 16 compliance with the provisions of this act. 17 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006, and applies to 18 employees hired on or after November 1, 2006.
