A HOUSE RESOLUTION ELECTING REPRESENTATIVE JAMES B. BLACK OF 1 2 COUNTY AS **SPEAKER** OF THE MECKLENBURG HOUSE OF 3 REPRESENTATIVES, TO CREATE THE OFFICE OF SPEAKER PRO 4 TEMPORE AND TO ELECT REPRESENTATIVE RICHARD T. MORGAN OF 5 MOORE COUNTY AS SPEAKER PRO TEMPORE, TO AUTHORIZE THE SPEAKER PRO TEMPORE TO APPOINT CHAIRS AND COCHAIRS OF 6 7 COMMITTEES AND STANDING SUBCOMMITTEES AS DESIGNATED BY 8 THE SPEAKER, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION OF THE SPEAKER 9 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE CASE OF A VACANCY. 10 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives: 11 **SECTION 1.** Representative James B. Black of Mecklenburg County is 12 elected Speaker of the House of Representatives. 13 SECTION 2. There is created the office of the Speaker Pro Tempore, and 14 Representative Richard T. Morgan of Moore County is elected Speaker Pro Tempore. Notwithstanding any rule adopted by the House of 15 SECTION 3. Representatives, the Speaker Pro Tempore, in consultation with the Speaker, shall 16 appoint such chairs and cochairs of committees and standing subcommittees as shall be 17 designated by the Speaker for appointment by the Speaker Pro Tempore. 18 Notwithstanding any rule adopted by the House of 19 SECTION 4. Representatives, in the case of a vacancy in the office of the Speaker of the House of 20 Representatives, the Principal Clerk shall preside over the House until the House elects 21 22 a Speaker. 23 **SECTION 5.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
