1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONTINUE THE WORK OF THE NORTH CAROLINA INDIAN ECONOMIC INITIATIVE TO PROMOTE JOBS AND OTHER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OPTIONS FOR INDIAN COMMUNITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of two hundred ten thousand dollars (\$210,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to promote long-term economic growth through the activities of the North Carolina Indian Economic Development Initiative. Funds will be used to provide business development services to entrepreneurs, to assist tribal organizations to develop their own business operations to produce revenue and jobs in rural communities, and to otherwise support the Initiative's economic development efforts.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
