1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING BOARDS TO ANNUALLY  
3 REPORT CERTAIN INFORMATION TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE  
4 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE, AS  
5 RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATIVE  
6 PROCEDURE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 93B-2 reads as rewritten:

9 **"§ 93B-2. Annual reports required; contents; open to inspection.**

10 (a) Each occupational licensing board shall file with the Secretary of State and  
11 ~~with the Attorney General an annual financial report, and State, the Attorney General,~~  
12 and the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee an annual  
13 report containing all of the following information:

- 14 (1) The address of the board, and the names of its members and  
15 ~~officers; officers.~~
- 16 (2) The number of persons who applied to the board for  
17 ~~examination; examination.~~
- 18 (3) The number who were refused ~~examination; examination.~~
- 19 (4) The number who took the ~~examination; examination.~~
- 20 (5) The number to whom initial licenses were ~~issued; issued.~~
- 21 (6) The number who applied for license by reciprocity or ~~eomity; comity.~~
- 22 (7) The number who were granted licenses by reciprocity or  
23 ~~eomity; comity.~~
- 24 (8) The number of licenses suspended or ~~revoked; and revoked.~~
- 25 (9) The number of licenses terminated for any reason other than failure to  
26 pay the required renewal fee.
- 27 (10) The substance of any anticipated request by the occupational licensing  
28 board to the General Assembly to amend statutes related to the  
29 occupational licensing board.

1           (11) The substance of any anticipated change in rules adopted by the  
2           occupational licensing board or the substance of any anticipated  
3           adoption of new rules by the occupational licensing board.

4           (b) Each occupational licensing board shall file with the Secretary of State, the  
5           Attorney General, and the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight  
6           Committee a financial report that includes the source and amount of all funds credited to  
7           the occupational licensing board and the purpose and amount of all funds disbursed by  
8           the occupational licensing board during the previous 12-month period.

9           (c) The reports required by this section shall be open to public inspection."

10           **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006. The first reports  
11           required by G.S. 93B-2, as amended by Section 1 of this act, are due no later than July  
12           1, 2007.
