A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2005 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, REGULAR SESSION 2006, TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY REQUIREMENT THAT CONCRETE BATCH FACILITIES REPORT ARSENIC COMPOUNDS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE PLACEMENT OF NEW PARTICULATE EMISSIONS CONTROL EQUIPMENT INTO OPERATION AT NEW OR EXISTING FACILITIES.

8 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

SECTION 1. The 2005 General Assembly, Regular Session 2006, may consider "A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY REQUIREMENT THAT CONCRETE BATCH FACILITIES REPORT ARSENIC COMPOUNDS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE PLACEMENT OF NEW PARTICULATE EMISSIONS CONTROL EQUIPMENT INTO OPERATION AT NEW OR EXISTING FACILITIES."
