A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO LEASE CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY TO ONSLOW COUNTY FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The State of North Carolina shall lease to Onslow County for a period of — years and for the payment of consideration in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00) per year the following described property which shall be used for recreational purposes, including soccer:

121.177 Acre Tract on N.C. Highway 210 9

- 10 Stump Sound Township, Onslow County, North Carolina
- 11 Commencing at an existing iron rod in the western right-of-way line of N.C. Highway
- 12 210 and being the northernmost property corner of Sneads Ferry Presbyterian Church as

- 14 and being THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING: thence from the above described true
- point of beginning and leaving said western right-of-way line South 42 degrees 21 15

- seconds East 100.88 feet, South 31 degrees 33 minutes 02 seconds East 100.95 feet, 28
- South 32 degrees 43 minutes 23 seconds East 100.93 feet, South 33 degrees 53 minutes 29

Highway 210, thence along 10 said western right-of-way line the following courses and distances: South 39 degrees 52 minutes 59 seconds East 101.57 feet, South 41 degrees 02 minutes 21 seconds East 11 12 101.35 feet South 42 degrees 52 minutes 25 seconds East 101.39 feet, South 44 degrees 13 30 minutes 53 seconds East 101.09 feet, South 45 degrees 05 minutes 13 seconds East 14 100.29 feet, South 45 degrees 33 minutes 23 seconds East 100.81 feet, South 45 degrees 47 minutes 02 seconds East 100.65 feet and South 47 degrees 04 minutes 49 seconds 15 16 East 115.34 feet to an existing iron rod in said western right-of-way line and being the 17 point and place of beginning. Containing 121.177 acres as calculated by Charles Francis Riggs, P.L.S. L-2981 on March 9, 2006 and not from an actual field survey. 18

SECTION 2. The Department of Administration shall execute an agreement between the State and Onslow County for the lease of the property described in Section 1 of this act. The lease agreement shall provide that Onslow County, as lessee, may sublease the property to a public or private entity to use for recreational purposes, including soccer. The County may sublease the property for such price and upon such terms and conditions that the County deems appropriate. The sublessee may alter the condition of the property, including cutting and removing timber, to make the property suitable for recreational purposes, including soccer. The County shall not sublease the property for a period of years greater than the lease between the State and the County.

SECTION 3. The lease agreement between the State and Onslow County does not require the approval of the Governor or the Council of State.

SECTION 4. The Department of Administration shall complete the lease agreement with Onslow County by October 1, 2006.

SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
