A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH TWO ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND TWO ADDITIONAL VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANTS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 24.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred sixty-nine thousand three hundred eighty dollars (\$169,380) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorneys authorized by this act.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of ninety-six thousand seven hundred eight dollars (\$96,708) for

1 the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish two additional victim witness assistant positions
2 for Prosecutorial District 24.

3 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
