2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN APPRAISAL, EXPERT		
3	TESTIMONY, AND ANALYSES OF THE DIX HOSPITAL CAMPUS		
4	PROPERTY, AND TO COMPLETE THE WORK OF THE DIX PROPERTY		
5	STUDY COMMISSION AS RECOMMENDED BY THE DOROTHEA DIX		
6	HOSPITAL PROPERTY STUDY COMMISSION.		
7	Whereas, the Dorothea Dix Hospital Property Study Commission and its		
8	Oversight Committee have met often during the 2004 and 2005 interims; and		
9	Whereas, the Commission has received the Dorothea Dix Master Plan		
10	prepared by LandDesign; and		
11	Whereas, the Master Plan is extensive and contains multiple options for the		
12	use of the Dix Campus property; and		
13	Whereas, the Commission has also received public input as to other proposed		
14	uses of the Dix Campus property, including proposals to conserve existing buildings		
15	and the development of an urban park; and		
16	Whereas, the Commission lacks certain information that is pertinent to its		
17	being able to issue a final report, to wit, an appraisal of the Dix Campus and information		
18	regarding the conservation of historic buildings, and the successful development and		
19	financing of a modern urban park; and		
20	Whereas, the Commission believes that with that information it will be able		
21	to finish its deliberations and report its final findings and recommendations to the 2007		
22	Regular Session of the 2007 General Assembly; Now therefore,		
23	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
24	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General		
25	Assembly, Legislative Services Commission, the sum of thirty thousand dollars		
26	(\$30,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the Dorothea Dix Hospital		
27	Property Commission (Commission) to be used to:		
28	a. Enter into a contract for obtaining an appraisal of the fair		
29	market value of the area known as the Dorothea Dix Hospital		

1		Campus taking into account information regarding the current
2		and future public use of the buildings and land, conservation of
3		historic buildings, and the development and financing of a
4		modern urban park;
5	b.	Reimburse the costs of an analysis of the potential for
6		rehabilitation and use of historic buildings; and
7	с.	Reimburse the costs of obtaining experts to testify on land use
8		and financing issues.
9	SECTION 2	• This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
