SESSION LAW 2006-25 **HOUSE BILL 2273**

AN ACT TO PERMIT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES TO USE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IN CURRITUCK COUNTY AND IN THE TOWNS OF CRAMERTON AND DALLAS, AND TO PERMIT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER USE IN THE TOWN OF HIGHLANDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of S.L. 2004-108, as amended by Section 1 of S.L. 2005-305, reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies to the City of Albemarle and the Towns of Beaufort, <u>Highlands</u>, Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act applies to the Towns of <u>Cramerton</u>, <u>Dallas</u>, <u>Duck</u>, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, Nags Head, and the City of Kings Mountain and the County of Currituck only. The term 'municipal employee' shall include employees of a county."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 26th day of June, 2006.
