May 24, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO IMPROVE STUDENT PERFORMANCE AT A HIGH SCHOOL DESIGNATED AS LOW-PERFORMING. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: There is appropriated from the General Fund to the **SECTION 1.** Cumberland County Public Schools the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to improve student performance at E.E. Smith High School, a high school that is designated as low-performing in the Leandro litigation.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
