A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A FAIR MINIMUM WAGE
3 FOR NONCERTIFIED PUBLIC SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHOSE SALARIES
4 ARE SUPPORTED FROM THE STATE'S GENERAL FUND.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7 Department of Public Instruction the sum of eight million five hundred eighty-two
8 thousand seventy-three dollars (\$8,582,073) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide
9 that permanent full-time noncertified public school employees whose salaries are
10 supported from the State's General Fund shall be paid a minimum salary of at least
11 twenty thousand one hundred twelve dollars (\$20,112) per year. Permanent, full-time
12 employees working on a schedule requiring less than 12 months' service per year and
13 permanent part-time employees, whose salaries are supported from the State's General
14 Fund, shall be paid the minimum salary pro rata.

15 **SECTION 1.(b)** The fair minimum wage established by this act shall be
16 calculated and awarded after any across-the-board salary increases authorized by the
17 General Assembly.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
