AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS OF NORTH CAROLINA.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Boys Club of Wake County, Inc., a nonprofit organization and the lead agency for the Boys and Girls Clubs of North Carolina, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the various boys and girls clubs across the State for computers, technology equipment, and support. These funds shall be used to assist with the partnership between the Boys and Girls Clubs of America and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children regarding NetSmart, an interactive and educational program to teach Internet safety and prevent child victimization.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
