A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN INCOME TAX INCENTIVE TO RECEIVE
PREVENTIVE HEALTH SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 105-134.6(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
read:

"(b) Deductions. – The following deductions from taxable income shall be made
in calculating North Carolina taxable income, to the extent each item is included in
taxable income:

...

(18) The amount paid by the taxpayer for preventive health services for the
taxpayer or the taxpayer's dependents. For the purpose of this
subdivision, the term 'preventive health services' means the services
listed in this subdivision. The term does not include amounts paid for
insurance that covers preventive health services but does include
insurance deductibles or co-payments associated with preventive
health services.

a. Periodic medical, dental, and vision examinations.

b. Patient health education, including nutrition education.

c. Maintenance of drug use profiles, patient drug monitoring, and
drug utilization education.

d. Mental health preventive services.

e. Substance abuse prevention measures.

f. Immunizations against infectious disease.

g. Prevention of musculoskeletal deformity or other gradually
developing disabilities of a metabolic or degenerative nature.

- 1 h. Genetic counseling concerning inheritance of genetically
2 determined diseases.
3 i. Periodic reexamination of members of high-risk groups for
4 selected diseases and for functional decline of sensory organs,
5 together with attendant appropriate remedial intervention."

6 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after
7 January 1, 2005.
