A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT EXPANDING PERMITTED USES OF 911 FUNDS IN PITT COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 62A-8(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Money from the Emergency Telephone System Fund shall be used only to pay for:

(1) The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone equipment, including necessary computer hardware, software and database provisioning, addressing, mobile radio equipment receivers and transmitters, base stations, communication towers, any additional equipment necessary for interconnectivity between police, fire, rescue units, and individuals, and nonrecurring costs of establishing a 911 system, and system.

(2) The rates associated with the service supplier's 911 service and other service supplier recurring charges."

SECTION 2. This act applies to Pitt County only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
