Short Title: Fayetteville Annexation Referendum. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE TO
3 REQUIRE APPROVAL OF ANNEXATIONS BY THE VOTERS OF THE AREA
4 TO BE ANNEXED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Chapter II of the Charter of the City of Fayetteville, being
7 Chapter 557 of the 1979 Session Laws, as amended, is amended by adding the
8 following new Article:

9 "Article 3. Annexation Referendum.

10 "§2.5. Annexation referendum. (a) An annexation ordinance adopted by the City of
11 Fayetteville under G.S. 160A-49(e) shall become effective only if approved by the
12 voters of the area to be annexed in a referendum conducted under subsection (b) of this
13 section.

14 (b) The City Council shall call a referendum to determine whether the proposed
15 territory shall be annexed to the City. Within 90 days after receiving a resolution calling
16 a referendum from the City Council, the Cumberland County Board of Elections shall
17 proceed to hold an election on the question.

18 The election shall be called by a resolution of the County Board of Elections that
19 shall:

- 20 (1) Describe the territory proposed to be annexed to the City as set out in
21 the resolution of the City Council.
22 (2) Provide that the matter of annexation of the territory shall be submitted
23 to the vote of the qualified voters of the territory proposed to be
24 annexed.
25 (3) Provide for registration of voters in the territory proposed to be
26 annexed for the election in accordance with G.S. 163-288.2.

27 The resolution shall be published in one or more newspapers of the county once a
28 week for 30 days prior to the closing of the registration books. The City shall pay all
29 costs of holding the election. Except as provided in this section, the election shall be

1 held under the same statutes, rules, and regulations as are applicable to elections in the
2 City.

3 At the election, the question on the ballot shall be:

4 " FOR AGAINST
5 Annexation."

6 If at the election, a majority of the votes cast from the area proposed for annexation
7 shall be "For Annexation", the annexation ordinance shall become effective as provided
8 by Article 4A of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, but not prior to the date of
9 certification of the results of the election."

10 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
