HOUSE BILL 643

Short Title: Speed and Traffic Defeating Devices.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF ANY DEVICE DESIGNED TO PREVENT
3 THE DETECTION OF A DRIVING VIOLATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
6 new section to read:

7 "**§ 20-141.7. Traffic regulation defeating devices prohibited.**

8 It shall be an infraction for any person to knowingly employ any device to prevent
9 the use of traffic monitoring and detection systems. The devices shall include, but not be
10 limited to, chemical sprays or plate covers designed to defeat traffic monitoring devices
11 or electronic devices to defeat speed detection radar systems and speed detection laser
12 systems. These prohibited devices shall not include radar or laser detecting devices."

13 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to
14 offenses committed on or after that date.
