5	SEC	TION 1. G.S. 95-117 reads as rewritten:	
6	"§ 95-117. Def		
7		or term defined in this Article has the meaning indicated in this section,	
8	unless a different meaning is plainly required by the context.		
9	(1)	'Commissioner' means the Commissioner of Labor of the State of	
10		North Carolina.	
11	(2)	'Industry' means activities of all those persons in the State who own,	
12		manage, or direct the operation of passenger tramways.	
13	(3)	'Operator' means any person, firm, corporation, or organization which	
14		owns, manages, or directs the operation of a passenger tramway.	
15		'Operator' may apply to the State or any political subdivision or	
16		instrumentality thereof.	
17	(4)	'Passenger tramway' means a device used to transport passengers	
18		uphill on skis, or in cars on tracks, or suspended in the air by the use of	
19		steel cables, chains or belts, or by ropes, and usually supported by	
20		trestles or towers with one or more spans. 'Passenger tramway' shall	
21		include the following devices:	
22		a. 'Chairlift,' a type of transportation on which passengers are	
23		carried on chairs suspended in the air and attached to a moving	
24		cable, chain or link belt supported by trestles or towers with one	
25		or more spans, or similar devices;	
26		b. <u>'Conveyor,' a type of transportation on which passengers are</u>	
27		transported uphill on a flexible moving element (conveyor belt)	

1		that travels uphill on one path and generally returns underneath	
2		the uphill portion.	
3	<u>b.c.</u>	'J bar, T bar or platter pull,' so-called and similar types of	
4	—	devices or means of transportation which pull skiers riding on	
5		skis by means of an attachment to a main overhead cable	
6		supported by trestles or towers with one or more spans;	
7	e. <u>d.</u>	'Multicar aerial passenger tramway,' a device used to transport	
8	—	passengers in several open or in closed cars attached to, and	
9		suspended from, a moving wire rope or attached to a moving	
10		wire rope and supported on a standing wire rope, or similar	
11		device;	
12	<u>d.e.</u>	'Rope tow,' a type of transportation which pulls the skiers,	
13	—	riding on skis as the skier grasps the rope manually, or similar	
14		devices;	
15	e.<u>f.</u>	'Skimobile,' a device in which a passenger car running on steel	
16	—	or wooden tracks is attached to and pulled by a steel cable, or	
17		similar device;	
18	<u>f.g.</u>	'Two-car aerial passenger tramway,' a device used to transport	
19	C C	passengers in two open or enclosed cars attached to, and	
20		suspended from, a moving wire rope or attached to a moving	
21		wire rope and supported on a standing wire rope or similar	
22		device."

25	No passenger tramy	vay shall be operated in this State unless it has been registered by	
26	the Commissioner of L	abor. On or before November 1 in each year, every operator of a	
27	passenger tramway shall apply to the Commissioner of Labor, on forms prepared by		
28	said Commissioner, for registration of the passenger tramway which such operator owns		
29		ation of which he directs.	
30	(a) <u>No person sl</u>	nall operate or permit to be operated or use any device subject to	
31		rticle without a valid registration certificate.

40	SECTION 3. G.S. 95-119 reads as rewritten:

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1	The Commissioner shall issue to the applying operator without delay a registration
2	certificate for each passenger tramway owned, managed, or the operation of which is
3	directed by such operator when the Commissioner is satisfied:
4	(1) That the facts stated in the application are sufficient to enable the
5	Commissioner to fulfill his duties under this Article; and
6	(2) That each such passenger tramway sought to be registered complies
7	with the rules and regulations of the Commissioner promulgated
8	pursuant to the provisions of this Article.
9	(3) In order to satisfy himself that the conditions described in subdivisions
10	(1) and (2) of this section have been fulfilled, the Commissioner may
11	cause to be made such inspections hereinafter described as he may
12	reasonably deem necessary.
13	(4) When an operator installs a passenger tramway subsequent to
14	November 1, of any year, such operator shall file a supplemental
15	application for registration of such passenger tramway. Upon the
16	receipt of such supplemental application, the Commissioner shall
17	proceed immediately to initiate proceedings leading to the registration
18	or rejection of registration of such passenger tramway pursuant to the
19	provisions of this Article.
20	(5) Each registration shall expire on October 31, next following the day of
21	issue. Each operator shall cause the registration certificate for each
22	passenger tramway thus registered to be displayed prominently at the
23	place where passengers are loaded thereon.
24	(a) A registration certificate shall be issued without delay when the
25	Commissioner is satisfied that the facts stated in the application are sufficient to enable
26	the Commissioner to fulfill his or her duties under this Article and that the device
27	sought to be registered complies with the rules adopted pursuant to this Article. Each
28	registration certificate shall expire on October 31 of the year next following the date of
29	issuance.
30	(b) The Commissioner may conduct any inspections necessary to determine
31	whether the device sought to be registered complies with the intent of this Article and
32	the rules adopted pursuant to this Article.
33	(c) <u>The registration certificate for each device subject to the provisions of this</u>
34	Article shall be displayed prominently at the place where passengers are loaded onto the
35	device."
36	SECTION 4. G.S. 95-120 reads as rewritten:
37	"§ 95-120. Powers and duties of the Commissioner.
38	In addition to all other powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the
39	Commissioner by this Article, the Commissioner shall have and exercise the following
40	powers and duties:
41	(1) To adopt and enforce reasonable rules and regulations relating to
42	public safety in the construction, operation, and maintenance of
43	passenger tramways.adopt, modify, or revoke the rules necessary for
44	carrying out the provisions of this Article, including those governing

1		the design, construction, installation, operation, use, and maintenance
2		of devices subject to the provisions of this Article. The rules and
3		regulations authorized adopted under this section shall conform as
4		
		nearly as possible to the standards contained for mechanical
5		engineering aerial passenger tramways safety code as adopted and
6		used by the U.S.A. Standards Institute, B77.1-1960, with addenda
7		B77.1(a)-1963, and B77.1(b)-1965, and as said safety code from [for]
8		tramways may be amended from time to time, and in the formulation
9		of said regulations the Commissioner may use and adopt any other
10		safety code for tramways as issued by recognized scientific and
11		mechanical societies. The said regulations shall not be discriminatory
12		in their application to operators of passenger tramways, and the
13		procedures of the Commissioner shall be as provided in this Article; in
14		the B77.1 – American National Standards Safety Requirements for
15		Aerial Passenger Tramways and with good engineering and safety
16	<i></i>	standards, formulas, and practices.
17	<u>(1a)</u>	To enforce the rules adopted under this Article.
18	<u>(1b)</u>	To grant exceptions from the requirements of the rules adopted under
19		this Article and to permit the use of other devices when the exceptions
20		and uses will not expose the public to an unsafe condition likely to
21		result in serious personal injury or damage to property.
22	(2)	To hold hearings and take evidence in all matters relating to the
23		exercise and performance of the powers and duties vested in the
24		Commissioner, subpoena witnesses, administer oaths, and compel the
25		testimony of witnesses and the production of books, papers and
26		records relevant to any inquiry; inquiry.
27	(3)	To approve, deny, revoke, and renew the registrations provided for in
28		this Article and the procedures of the Commissioner with respect
29		thereto shall be as provided in this Article with respect to the issuance
30		of certificates or licenses; registration certificates in accordance with
31		the rules adopted pursuant to this Article.
32	(4)	To cause the prosecution and the institution of actions for injunctions
33		of all persons violating the provisions of this Article and to incur the
34		necessary expenses thereof; institute civil actions for injunctive or other
35		relief against violators of this Article.
36	(5)	To cause the seal of the Commissioner of Labor to be affixed to all
37		registrations issued by him, the Commissioner, and to employ, within
38		the funds available to him, the Commissioner, and prescribe the duties
39		of all such the personnel as the Commissioner may deem necessary in
40		the administration of this Article.
41	<u>(6)</u>	To have reasonable access, with or without notice, to the devices
42		subject to the provisions of this Article during reasonable hours, for
43		the purposes of inspections and testing.
