HOUSE BILL 862**

**AN ACT TO MAKE THE LAW PROHIBITING THE REMOVAL OF ELECTRONIC
COLLARS FROM DOGS APPLY STATEWIDE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-401.17(d) is repealed.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
