9	(5) The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when added to		
10	the area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not exceed ten		
11	percent (10%) of the area within the primary corporate limits of the		
12	annexing city.		
13	This subdivision does not apply to the Cities of Claremont,		
14	Concord, Conover, Gastonia, Greenville, Hickory, Locust, Marion,		
15	Mount Airy, Mount Holly, New Bern, Newton, Oxford, Randleman,		
16	Rockingham, Sanford, Salisbury, Southport, Statesville, and		
17	Washington and the Towns of Angier, Bladenboro, Calabash,		
18	Catawba, Creswell, Dallas, Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Godwin, Holly		
19	Ridge, Holly Springs, Kenly, Knightdale, Leland, Louisburg, Maiden,		
20	Mayodan, Midland, Mocksville, Morrisville, Pembroke, Pine Level,		
21	Ranlo, Rolesville, Rutherfordton, Swansboro, Troy, Wallace, Warsaw,		
22	Waynesville, Wendell, and Zebulon."
