A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO REDUCE THE DEER POPULATION IN NORTH CAROLINA.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, during any season
for the taking of deer established by the Wildlife Resources Commission there shall be
no bag limits on deer and deer of either sex may be taken.
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to deer
seasons established for the 2004-2005 and 2005-2006 hunting seasons.
