**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million three hundred eighty-four thousand four hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$1,384,498) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to be allocated to Appalachian State University as equity funding. The purpose of the equity funding is to bring the full-time equivalency (FTE) funding for that campus to an acceptable level consistent with the level of funding of other campuses of The University of North Carolina.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
