A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUEST THAT THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION STUDY THE ISSUE OF INTEGRATING A LIVING WILL WITH THE DRIVERS LICENSE PROCESS, SIMILAR TO ORGAN DONATION, WITH A STANDARDIZED LIVING WILL.

SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission is requested to study the feasibility of integrating with the drivers license process, another process similar to the organ donor question. The additional question would be whether or not the licensee wanted to have a living will and some way of adapting a standardized version of a valid North Carolina living will.

SECTION 2. The report requested by this act shall be made at least 10 days before the 2005 Regular Session of the General Assembly reconvenes in 2006.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
