Short Title: Scholar Student/NC Resident. (Public) **Sponsors:** Senator Rand. Referred to: Education/Higher Education. March 24, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A FULL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT WHO ATTENDS A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA SHALL BE CONSIDERED AND TREATED FOR ALL PURPOSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AS A RESIDENT OF NORTH CAROLINA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 14 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 116-143.6. Full scholarship students attending constituent institutions. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any nonresident person who receives a full scholarship to a constituent institution and who attends the institution shall be considered and treated for all purposes of The University of North Carolina as a resident of North Carolina. The following definitions apply in this section: (b) 'Full scholarship' means a grant that meets the full cost for a student to attend the constituent institution for an academic year. 'Full cost' means an amount calculated by the constituent institution (2) that is no less than the sum of in-State tuition, required fees, on-campus room and board, and required course-related books."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to

students who receive full scholarships on or after that date.
