A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE MANDATE THAT CHILDREN ENTERING
2 KINDERGARTEN OBTAIN A COMPREHENSIVE EYE EXAMINATION, THE
3 GOVERNOR'S VISION CARE PROGRAM, AND THE GOVERNOR'S
4 COMMISSION ON EARLY CHILDHOOD VISION CARE; AND TO PROVIDE
5 THAT FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE RESERVE FOR THE GOVERNOR'S
6 VISION CARE PROGRAM SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** Section 10.59F of S.L. 2005-276, as amended by Section 20 of
10 S.L. 2005-345, and Part 35 of Article 3 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes are
11 repealed.

12 **SECTION 2.** Effective June 30, 2006, funds in the Reserve for the
13 Governor's Vision Care Program shall revert to the General Fund.

14 **SECTION 3.** Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act is effective
15 when it becomes law.
