A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES AND NEEDS IN HERTFORD COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated for a six-month comprehensive feasibility study of public health needs in order to obtain federal funding and leverage existing State and local dollars. This study will be conducted in conjunction with the Hertford County Public Health Authority.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
