AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A NEW DISTRICT COURT
JUDGE IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 6A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

**"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional
seats of court, by counties.**

(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the
following table:

43 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge
 44 for District 6A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the

1 2008 general election for a four-year term commencing on the first Monday in
2 December 2008.

3 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
4 Department the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred seventy-two dollars (\$89,172)
5 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the new district court judge for District Court
6 District 6A authorized by this act.

7 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 15, 2006, or the date
8 upon which Section 1 of this act is approved under section 5 of the Voting Rights Act,
9 whichever is later.
