SENATE BILL 1333

Short Title: Require Odometer Disclosure By Sellers. (Public)

Sponsors: Senator Bingham.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANY PERSON TRANSFERRING A MOTOR VEHICLE TO
PROVIDE AN ODOMETER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT ON A VEHICLE TEN
YEARS OLD OR OLDER BUT LESS THAN TWENTY YEARS OLD IF THE
TRANSFeree REQUESTS THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-347(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) The provisions of this disclosure statement section shall not apply to the following transfers:

- (1) A vehicle having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 16,000 pounds;
- (2) A vehicle that is not self-propelled;
- (2a) A vehicle sold directly by the manufacturer to any agency of the United States in conformity with contractual specifications;
- (3) A vehicle that is 10 years old or ~~older~~; older, provided that a vehicle that is 10 years old or older but less than 20 years old shall have an odometer disclosure statement provided by the transferor to the transferee if a transferee requests the disclosure statement; or
- (4) A new vehicle prior to its first transfer for purposes other than resale."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2006.
