A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO PURCHASE VACCINES FOR THE FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF A UNIVERSAL CHILDHOOD VACCINE PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of thirty-one million three hundred seventy-five thousand one hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$31,375,199) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to purchase childhood vaccines for the full implementation of a Universal Childhood Vaccine Program in North Carolina to assure the vaccination of the children of this State.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
