A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO PROVIDE AN INCREASE IN THE
LEGISLATIVE TUITION GRANT FOR CERTAIN NORTH CAROLINA
RESIDENTS ENROLLED IN QUALIFIED NONPROFIT, PRIVATE COLLEGES
OR UNIVERSITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifteen million seven
hundred forty-seven thousand dollars (\$15,747,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to
provide an increase in the legislative tuition grants to aid students attending private
institutions of higher education. These funds shall be disbursed in accordance with
G.S. 116-21.2 through G.S. 116-22 to provide a legislative tuition grant of two thousand
three hundred dollars (\$2,300) to each student who qualifies for a legislative tuition
grant.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
