a town may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of electric golf carts or	n any public
street or road within the town.	
By ordinance, a town may require the registration of golf carts,	charge a fee
for the registration, specify the persons authorized to operate golf carts, and	d specify the
required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of g	golf carts.
SECTION 2. This act applies only to the Towns of Ros	se Hill and
Bladenboro.	
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
