A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH TWO ADDITIONAL
DISTRICT COURT JUDGESHIPS IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 14.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

41 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the two additional district court
42 judges for District 14 authorized by this act, and those judges' successors shall be
43 elected in the 2008 election for four-year terms commencing on the first Monday in
44 December 2008.

1 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
2 Department the sum of one hundred fifty-seven thousand ninety-six dollars (\$157,096)
3 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the two additional district court judgeships for
4 District Court District 14 authorized by this act.

5 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective January 15, 2007.
