| 8  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 2.(b) of S.L. 2002-181 reads as rewritten:                        |
| 9  | "SECTION 2.(b) This act expires June 30, 2006. June 30, 2009. The expiration of             |
| 10 | this act does not affect prosecutions for offenses committed before that date, and the      |
| 11 | statutes that would be applicable but for this act remain applicable to those prosecutions. |
| 12 | The expiration of this act does not affect any guarantees or bonds executed prior to the    |
| 13 | expiration."  |
| 14 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the                        |
| 15 | Department of Commerce the sum of twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000) for the        |
| 16 | 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Small Business Contractor       |
| 17 | Authority for the purpose of making loans and providing financial assistance authorized     |
| 18 | under the Small Business Contractor Act (Part 19 of Article 10 of Chapter 143B of the       |
| 19 | General Statutes). These funds shall be allocated as follows:                               |
| 20 | (1) \$10,000,000 Small Business Contract Financing Fund                                     |
| 21 | (2) \$15,000,000 Small Business Surety Bond Fund.   |
| 22 | <b>SECTION 3.</b> Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006. The                 |
| 23 | remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.                                     |
