A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE  
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO CONSTRUCT AN ALLIED  
HEALTH AND NURSING BUILDING AT APPALACHIAN STATE  
UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of forty million dollars  
(\$40,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to Appalachian State  
University to construct an Allied Health and Nursing Building. The facility will be  
developed in concert with the Watauga Regional Medical Center, which has agreed to  
donate sufficient land. The building will provide a central location for the approved  
nursing program and the consolidation of other academic and research programs in  
Allied Health.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
