A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR RENOVATION PROJECTS AND A
NEW EDUCATION FACILITY AT THE TRI-COUNTY COMMUNITY
COLLEGE, GRAHAM COUNTY CENTER.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North
Carolina Community Colleges System Office the sum of two million dollars
(\$2,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for capital needs at the Tri-County
Community College's Graham County Center. These funds shall be used as follows:
(1) For renovation projects, including communication upgrade, floor
coverings, painting, landscaping, and restroom renovation.
(2) To construct a new education facility to provide adequate space to
meet the demands of an eighty-two percent (82%) increase in student
enrollment and serve over 1,800 continuing education students.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
