A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF PARKS AND RECREATION, TO CONSERVE LAND IN RUTHERFORD AND HYDE COUNTIES AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES TO CONSERVE LAND IN HYDE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year a 200-acre natural area project located in Rutherford County.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for a three-acre historic site located on Ocracoke Island in Hyde County. This site is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
