A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN FARM VEHICLES AND IMPLEMENTS FROM  
REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-51 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"**§ 20-51. Exempt from registration.**

The following shall be exempt from the requirement of registration and certificate of title:

...

(16) Any vehicle that meets all of the following:

- a. Is designed for use in work off the highway.
- b. Is a farm implement or tractor as defined in G.S. 20-4.01 and is used solely for agricultural purposes.
- c. The farm implement or tractor as defined in G.S. 20-4.01 and shall be used for a period of time less than five weeks out of any calendar year.
- c. Is driven or moved on the highway for the purpose of going to and from nonhighway projects.
- d. Is identified in a manner approved by the Division of Motor Vehicles.
- e. Is operated by a person who is exempt from licensing requirements of G.S. 20-8(2)."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2007.
