SENATE BILL 338**

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF AHOSKIE TO GIVE ANNUAL NOTICE  
TO CHRONIC VIOLATORS OF THE TOWN'S OVERGROWN VEGETATION  
ORDINANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of S.L. 1999-58, as amended by S.L. 2000-33, S.L. 2000-38, S.L. 2001-107, S.L. 2003-77, S.L. 2003-80, and S.L. 2005-81, reads as rewritten:

"Section 2. This act applies to the Towns of Ahoskie, Ayden, Leland, and Pineville, and to the Cities of Durham, Gastonia, High Point, Lexington, Monroe, Roanoke Rapids, Rocky Mount, and Winston-Salem only."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2005.
