2	AN ACT TO AGGRAVATE THE PENALTY FOR THE LARCENY, POSSESSION,
3	OR RECEIVING OF GOODS VALUED AT MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED

5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Article 16 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
7	adding a new section to read:
8	"§ 14-72.6. Felonious larceny, possession, or receiving of stolen goods from a
9	permitted construction site.
0	(a) <u>A person is guilty of a Class I felony if he commits any of the following</u>
1	offenses, where the goods are valued in excess of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) but
2	less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000):
3	(1) Larceny of goods from a permitted construction site.
4	(2) Possessing or receiving of stolen goods, with actual knowledge or
5	having reasonable grounds to believe that the goods were stolen from a
6	permitted construction site.
7	(b) If a person convicted under subsection (a) of this section is not subject to an
8	active or intermediate punishment under G.S. 15A-1340.17, the person may be
9	sentenced to an active punishment of up to 30 days, in addition to any authorized
0	community punishment.
1	(c) As used in this section, a 'permitted construction site' is a site where a permit,
2	license, or other authorization has been issued by the State or a local governmental
3	entity for the placement of new construction or improvements to real property."
4	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to
5	offenses committed on or after that date. Prosecutions for offenses committed before
6	the effective date of this act are not abated or affected by this act, and the statutes that
7	would be applicable but for this act remain applicable to those prosecutions.
