A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE KIDS VOTING OF NORTH CAROLINA PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Kids Voting of North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to be used as follows:

- (1) \$50,000 to implement new Kids Voting programs in nonparticipating counties across the State.
- (2) \$200,000 to be divided on the basis of the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction's Average Daily Membership with a minimum of \$2,500 for the following counties: Buncombe, Cabarrus, Catawba, Clay, Cumberland, Durham, Greene, Guilford, Haywood, Henderson, Iredell, Jackson, Madison, Mecklenburg, New Hanover, Onslow, Randolph, and Wake to assist those counties with their Kids Voting programs.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
