A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH TWO NEW DISTRICT
COURT JUDGES IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 10.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

39 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judges
40 for District 10 authorized by this act, and those judges' successors shall be elected in the
41 2006 general election for four-year terms commencing on the first Monday in December
42 2006.

43 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
44 Department the sum of two hundred thirteen thousand five hundred seventy-six dollars

1 (\$213,576) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty-one thousand
2 eight hundred twenty-four dollars (\$251,824) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish
3 the two new district court judges for District Court District 10 authorized by this act.

4 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2005.
