5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-12 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 115C-12. Powers and duties of the Board generally.
8	The general supervision and administration of the free public school system shall be
9	vested in the State Board of Education. The State Board of Education shall establish
10	policy for the system of free public schools, subject to laws enacted by the General
11	Assembly. The powers and duties of the State Board of Education are defined as
12	follows:
13	
14	(29) To issue special high school diplomas to veterans of World War II.
15	World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. – The State Board of Education
16	shall issue special high school diplomas to all honorably discharged
17	veterans of World War II-World War II, the Korean Conflict, and the
18	Vietnam era who request special diplomas and have not previously
19	received high school diplomas."
20	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
