| 7 | SECTION 1. G.S. 14-269.4 reads as rewritten: |

| 9 | It shall be unlawful for any person to possess, or carry, whether openly or concealed, |
| 10 | any deadly weapon, not used solely for instructional or officially sanctioned ceremonial |
| 11 | purposes in the State Capitol Building, the Executive Mansion, the Western Residence |
| 12 | of the Governor, or on the grounds of any of these buildings, and in any building |
| 13 | housing any court of the General Court of Justice. If a court is housed in a building |
| 14 | containing nonpublic uses in addition to the court, then this prohibition shall apply only |
| 15 | to that portion of the building used for court purposes while the building is being used |
| 16 | for court purposes. |
