PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT(S) & PROGRAM(S) AFFECTED: City of Winston-Salem

EFFECTIVE DATE: Section 3 of this act becomes effective January 1, 2007. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.

BILL SUMMARY:

This bill would authorize the City of Winston-Salem to increase the motor vehicle tax levied on each vehicle listed in its jurisdiction from \$10 to \$15 effective immediately, and from \$15 to \$20 effective January 1, 2007. The revenue from the amount of the tax above \$10 is to be used for transportation-related purposes.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

The \$10 vehicle tax currently levied in the City of Winston-Salem generated \$1,424,168 in FY2004. Based on this information, the revenue for an increase of \$5 per vehicle is projected for 10 months of FY2006. The revenue for FY2007 is based on 6 months of a fee of \$15, and an increase to \$20 effective January 1, 2007.
