S 91. ENDANGERED MANUFACTURING AND JOBS ACT (=H 39). Filed 2/7/07. *TO PROVIDE ENHANCED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES TO ENDANGERED MANUFACTURERS, TO PROVIDE PROPERTY TAX EXCLUSIONS FOR ENDANGERED MANUFACTURERS, TO CLARIFY THAT A LOW-PROFIT LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IS A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY UNDER STATE LAW, TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CAROLINA FURNITURE FUND TO RECEIVE STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDING FOR THE FURNITURE INDUSTRY, TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CAROLINA FURNITURE COUNCIL TO ADMINISTER THE FUND, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE, TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THE FURNITURE TECHNOLOGY CENTER, TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FOR THE UNAUTHORIZED DISCLOSURE OF TRADE SECRETS, AND TO CLARIFY THAT INDUSTRIAL MACHINERY IS NOT SUBJECT TO REGULATION UNDER THE BUILDING CODE.* Identical to H 39, filed 1/30/07.
