6	"§ 14-440.1. Unlawful operation of an audiovisual recording device.				
7	(a) Definitions. – The following definitions apply to this section:				
8	(1) "Audiovisual recording device" means a digital or analog photographic				
9	or video camera, or any other technology or device now known or later				
10	developed, capable of recording, copying, or transmitting a motion				
11	picture, or any part thereof, regardless of whether audiovisual				
12	recording is the sole or primary purpose of the device.				
13	(2) "Motion picture theater" means a movie theater, screening room, or				
14	other venue that is being utilized primarily for the exhibition of a				
15	motion picture at the time of the offense.				
16	(b) Offense. – Any person who knowingly operates or attempts to operate an

19	motion picture theater owner shall be guilty of a violation of this section.				
20	(c) Penalty. – A violation of this section is punishable as follows:				
21	(1) Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law				
22	providing greater punishment, any person convicted of a violation of				
23	this section is guilty of:				
24	a. A Class <del>1 misdemeanor, <u>I</u> felony, if the violation is a first</del>				
25	offense under this section.section, with a minimum fine of two				
26	thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500).

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
