4	The General Ass	sembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECT	FION 1. G.S. 153A-335, as it applies to Stanly County pursuant to
6	Chapter 930 of	the 1987 Session Laws, as amended by S.L. 1991-504, S.L. 1993-574,
7	S.L. 1998-37, ar	nd S.L. 1998-217, reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 153A-335. 'Subdivision' defined.	
9	For purposes	of this Part, 'subdivision' means all divisions of a tract or parcel of land
10	into two or more lots, building sites, or other divisions for the purpose, whether	
11	immediate or fu	ture, of sale or building development, and shall include all divisions of
12	land involving the dedication of a new street or change in existing streets. The following	
13	shall not be included within this definition nor be subject to any regulations enacted	
14	pursuant to this	
15	(1)	The combination or recombination of portions of previously
16		subdivided and recorded lots if the total number of lots is not increased
17		and the resultant lots are equal to or exceed the standards of the county
18		as shown by the regulations prescribed by this act;
19	(2)	The division of land into parcels greater than 10 acres where no street
20		right-of-way dedication is involved;
21	(3)	The public acquisition by purchase of strips of land for widening or
22		opening streets;
23	(4)	The conveyance of a tract or parcel of land with a minimum of 20,000
24		square feet exclusive of the State right of way for a road with at least
25		100 feet frontage upon a State-maintained road;
26	(5)	The division of land pursuant to an order of the General Court of
27		Justice;

(Local)

1	(6) The conveyance of a lot or tract for the purpose of dividing land
2	among tenants in common, all of whom inherited, by intestacy or by
3	will, the land from a common ancestor; and
4	(7) The division of a tract in single ownership whose entire area is no
5	greater than two acres into no more than three lots, where no street
6	right-of-way dedication is involved, and where the resultant lots are
7	equal to or exceed the standards of the county, as shown by the
8	subdivision regulations contained in this act."
9	SECTION 2. This act applies to Stanly County only.
10	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies only to
11	subdivisions submitted to the Stanly County Planning Department for approval on or
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12 after that date.
