April 5, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT REQUIRING A PERSON CONVICTED OF A SEX OFFENSE WHO IS PURSUING CHILD CUSTODY EX PARTE TO DISCLOSE THE CONVICTION IN THE PLEADINGS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 50-13.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(a1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person instituting an action or proceeding for custody ex parte who has been convicted of a sexually violent offense as defined in G.S. 14-208.6(5) shall disclose the conviction in the pleadings."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
