5	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-115.1(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b) Motor vehicle combinations consisting of a semitrailer of not more than 53
7	eet in length and a truck tractor may be operated on the interstate highways (except
8	hose exempted by the United States Secretary of Transportation pursuant to 49 U.S.C.
9	2311(i)) and federal-aid primary system highways designated by the United States
10	Secretary of Transportation all highways of North Carolina provided that:
11	(1) Any semitrailer in excess of 48 feet in length shall not be permitted
12	unless:
13	a. The distance between the kingpin of the trailer and the rearmost
14	axle, or a point midway between the two rear axles, if the two
15	rear axles are a tandem axle, does not exceed 41 feet; or
16	b. The semitrailer is used exclusively or primarily to transport
17	vehicles in connection with motorsports competition events,
18	and the distance between the kingpin of the trailer and the
19	rearmost axle, or a point midway between the two rear axles, if
20	the two rear axles are a tandem axle, does not exceed 46 feet;
21	and (2) Any continuing in excess of 48 fact is equipped with a near up domide
22	(2) Any semitrailer in excess of 48 feet is equipped with a rear underride
23 24	guard of substantial construction consisting of a continuous lateral
24 25	beam extending to within four inches of the lateral extremities of the semitrailer and located not more than 30 inches from the surface as
25 26	measured with the vehicle empty and on a level surface."
